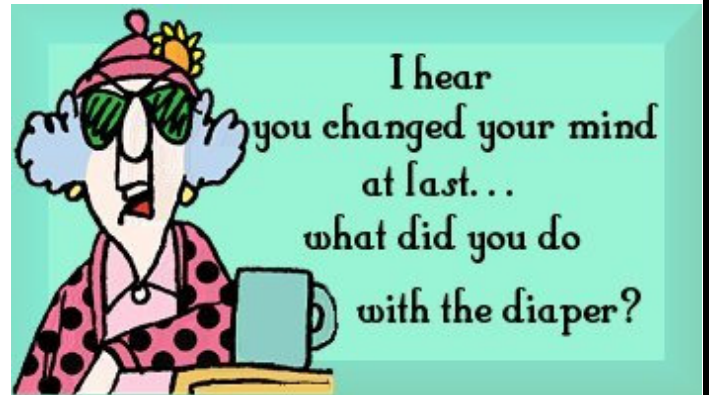
It's a Pot-luck meal so please bring your appetite and a dish to share along with a serving spoon if needed.
