A man, his wife, and mother-in-law went on vacation to Jerusalem. While they were there, the mother-in-law passed away.

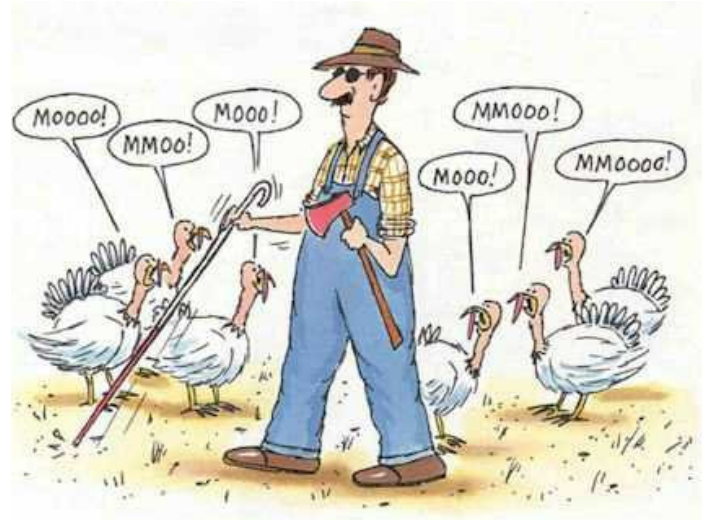
The undertaker told them:
